#### 3. Objective and outcomes of the programme:

As sanctioned by ASTEC (Letter No. ASTEC/ENV/1894/2018/3693, dated 17/11/2018), the Outreach Programme among the school students was organized on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of February, 2019 by the Dept. of Chemistry, M.C. College, Barpeta. The programme was named as 'Students' Scientific Seminar on Active Learning of Science' and was coordinated by Mr. Sameeran Kumar Das, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Chemistry, M. C. College. The main aim of the programme was to make the students interested in Science based on their school curriculum topics. Total 30

(Thirty) students from seven different nearby schools have participated in the programme. All the students were from class-IX standard. The organizers have planned a series of lectures and handson practices for the students based on class-IX science textbook on the topics of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Zoology and Botany). The students were given lectures on the topics by Resource persons. The details of the chapters/topics are enlisted below.

- i) Matter in our surroundings
- ii) Structure of matter: atoms and molecules
- iii) Motion, force, laws of motion, work and energy
- iv) Gravitation and sound
- v) The fundamental unit of life-Plant cells and tissues, Diversity in living organisms
- vi) Animal cells and tissues, Diversities in animal kingdom
- vii) Hands on practices in chemistry
- viii) Hands on practices in Physics
- ix) Hands on practices in Biology (Botany and Zoology)

The two days Outreach Programme was started on 27th of February, 2019 at the Digital classroom of M. C. College. The inaugural session was held at 9 AM which was hosted by the coordinator Mr. Sameeran Kumar Das. The welcome address was given by Dr. Dipanjali Pathak, Head, Department of Chemistry, M. C. College. The outreach programme was inaugurated by Dr. Smita Srivastav, Eminent Doctor, Barpeta. In the inaugurating speech, she motivates the students to learn Science and to improve their thinking with new knowledge. Dr. Pankaj Gogoi, Project Scientist, Outreach Programme, Environment Division, ASTEC joined the inaugural session and interacted with the students as well as with the teachers. After the inaugural session, the main technical sessions were begun. The students have actively participated in the programme. During the Botany and Zoology hands-on sessions, the students were familiarized with different plant as well as animal species and also with the microscopic world. During the Chemistry laboratory session, they were given specific training on separation of solvents, mixtures, chromatography, identification of radicals (acid/base) etc. During the Physics laboratory, the students were trained with experiments related to sound, motion, light etc. During all the hands on training, the students were allowed to carry on the experiments themselves under proper guidance of the resource persons. . They were delighted during the hands-on training session.

These sanitizer bottles were used by the police personnels engaged in covid duty. We exhausted the whole stock of alcohol, glycerol and hydrogen peroxide chemicals required for the preparation. Dr Robin Kumar, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Barpeta and Samiran Baishya, Additional Superintendent of Police, Barpeta were also actively engaged with this drive.


