AGREEMENT

This Agreement is executed at Barpeta on this 12th day of October 2015

BY AND BETWEEN

Reliance JioInfocomm Limited (RJIL), a company incorporated under the provisions of the Indian Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at 9th Floor, Maker Chambers N. 222, Nariman Point, Mumbai 400 021, acting through its authorized signatory Mr. Zaddikur Rahman of the First Part.

AND

CELF M.C College Barpeta, a college affiliated to Gauhati University and situated at Barpeta Town, Metuakuchi P.O&P.S - Barpeta, Dist-Barpeta (Assam) Pin-781301, represented herein by duly authorized signatory Dr. Prakash Sarma, son of Lt- Keshab Ch. Sarma, aged about 47 years, hereinafter referred to as the College of the OTHER PART;

RJIL is hereby granted permission to provide Telecommunication Services and installation of Small cell and other telecom related equipment in the location and as per details (space & equipment) mentioned at Appendix."A" thereby enabling customer ('the USER') to access our se vices from the site through Access Points/Small Cells/Other Equipment

The term is for 8 years, from the date of signing of this agreement. The agreement shall be automatically renewable after expiry of the initial term for a term equal to the initial term.

RJIL Responsibilities

- 1 Install and Commission Telecom equipment consisting of equipment and Cable i.e. Feeder and/or Optica Fiber Cable (OFC) etc. for providing telecommunication services in all Sites as mentioned in Appendix A and additional sites added in future as per the feasibility of RJIL.
- 2. Optimum deployment of Access Points/Small Cells and Installation of telecom equipment would be decided by RJIL installation team.
- Keeping the network operational and assisting in resolving network / equipment related issues (such as network faults, systemic issues and outages)
- 4. Operate and provide services through the Central Customer Care Center (enduser), to address customer (enduser) queries and concerns.
- Provide publicity to the Collegeby listing their Sites as available hotspots sites in RJIL's website or through any other means which RJIL deems fit.
- 6. RJIL reserves rights of Digital Marketing & Communication and for all changes in rate/ Tariff conditions and updates on Wi-Fi Hot spots. Digital spaces would always remain the property of RJIL, which includes platform like Landing Page, Login flow pages, RJIL website etc.
- Pricing and tariff planning of telecommunication service will be sole prerogative of RJIL.
- 8 RJIL will abide by DoT guidelines with respect to Maintaining customer (end user) usage records, Ensuring on-line security & privacy of users and Blocking of web contents
- RJIL will have the full rights to obtain and use the consumers' data, and use it as RJIL deems appropriate within Indian legal framework.
- 10.RJIL may modify, restrict, suspend or temporarily cease access to itsTelecommunication Services at any time in order to test the operation of itsnetwork or to carry out maintenance, technical repair, enhancement or emergency work.
- 11.RJIL shall be exclusive provider of its telecommunication services and Pico cell/ Femtocell/ Wi-Fi/ Small cells at the College Sites.

The College's Responsibilities & Rights

- The collegeis lawful owner and in possession of the Building and premises, namely M.C College Building.
- 2 Provide RJIL with required space at their location to setup relevant network equipment and a conducive operating environment (secure, ventilated, moisture free) for the equipment and permit the right to use the common areas stairways and passages and grant right of way in the said Building to RJIL to exclusively installation of its Telecommunication Equipment consisting of equipment and Cable i.e. Feeder and/or Optical Fiber Cable (OFC).
- 3 Provide space to establish helpdesk for public awareness.

- Provide access to all relevant areas of the site as required for maintenance team of RJIL
- Will have No Objection to RJIL carrying out promotion and marketing of its te ecommunication services
- 6. Ensure assets deployed by RJIL at sites are secure from any intentional damage o theft
- 7. The Collegeor any other person or entity acting under them shall not have any retention right, preferential claim or lien (or any other similar right) on Telecommunication Equipment including but not limited to its cables, wires. ducts, equipment and belongings of RJIL.
- 8. Any assignment by the Collegeeffected due to sale or transfer of Site /s under rights with respect to this Agreement remain unaffected. All equipment/ materials infrastructure, software or hardware installed by RJIL shall remain sole property of RJIL with title and applicable licenses resting with RJIL, unless otherwise stated in writing and will be handed over to RJIL if the Collegevacate such site/s premises.

Indemnification

Both parties indemnify each other and agree to keep each other indemnified-

- a) Against each and loss or damages, actions, proceedings etc. as either of the Parties may face or incur due to any act or omission of other party regarding compliance of municipal or other rules and regulations for the time being in force
- b) Against all losses or damages, which either of the Parties may face or incur due to any violation of any provision of this Agreement

"The College"indemnifies RJIL

- a) For any loss or damage suffered by RJIL on account of any defect in title with respect to the Demarcated Area, any tax, interest, penalty claims, etc.
- b) From any liability for any commitment made by it to an end-user/ its customer. The collegeacknowledges that RJIL cannot guarantee any user internet connectivity at the Location/s and RJIL shall not be responsible for any loss and/or damage (whether direct, consequential, or incidental, including but not limited to expenditures, loss of profits or prospective profits of any kind etc. whatsoever to the College or to the user or third party for non-availability of the internet access.

RJIL indemnifies the College

RJIL shall be responsible for all legal and regulatory obligations required for its services and shall indemnify the collegefrom any legal and regulatory obligations in relation to its License.

Termination

RJILshall have the right to terminate this Agreement, by giving 60(sixty) days' notice in writing to the college. Upon the expiry of 60(sixty) daysfrom the date of notice, as aforesaid, the Agreement shall stand terminated. The Collegeshall not have any right to terminate the agreement except for instances wherein RJIL has committed a material breach of terms provided herein and the same is not rectified by RJIL within 30 (thirty) days or intimation of such breach in writing by the college. In case the breach is committed by RLIL and is not rectified, the collegeshall be entitled to terminate the Agreement by giving 90. Ninety) days notice. On termination, all Marketing Material and Network installations provided by RJIL shall be removed by RJIL.

Governing Law&Jurisdiction

The provisions of this Agreement and the rights and obligations of the Parties under or arising out of this Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of India and the Courts of Barpeta shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the matters relating to or arising from this Agreement.
