



**FIELD VISIT REPORT**  
**A FIELD VISIT TO KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK**

**ON 06/11/23 AND 07/11/23**

**Introduction:**

On 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023, a field trip was organized for a group of 20 students (B.A 3<sup>rd</sup> semester honors along with B. A/B.SC 3<sup>rd</sup> semester generic and 5th-semester generic students) accompanied by teacher in-charges Dr. Koncheng Buragohain, Dr. Arzufa Khanom, to Kaziranga National Park, located in the Golaghat and Nagaon districts of Assam, beside the Brahmaputra River on the North and Karbi Anglong mounts on South India.

We departed from Madhab Choudhury College, Barpeta, at 5.30 am and reached Kaziranga National Park around 12.30 pm. Upon arrival, the park official warmly welcomed us and provided an overview of the park's history, geographical location, and key conservation projects undertaken.

**Objectives:**

The field visit to Kaziranga National Park aimed to provide students with first-hand experience and knowledge about the park's unique biodiversity and conservation efforts. The field visit was also organized to enhance the student's understanding of the park's ecological strategies, and the challenges faced in preserving the natural heritage.

**Observation:**

We embarked on a guided safari tour with an experienced park ranger. The safari vehicles took us through the different zones of the park, offering us a close encounter with its diverse wildlife and scenic landscapes. We observed various species, including the Indian rhinoceros, elephants, wild buffalo, monkeys, deer, and different species of birds and plant species. We have also visited the Orchid Park and observed more than 100 varieties of Orchids. We visited the cultural museum inside the park offering us different musical instruments and folk culture of Assam. We also had the opportunity to witness the mesmerizing cultural night, which featured dance and music that showcased the rich cultural diversity of Assam.

The field visit provided students with a comprehensive understanding of the importance of biodiversity conservation and the challenges faced in protecting natural habitats.

The students gained practical knowledge about flora and fauna found in Kaziranga National Park along with the rich cultural diversity of Assam.

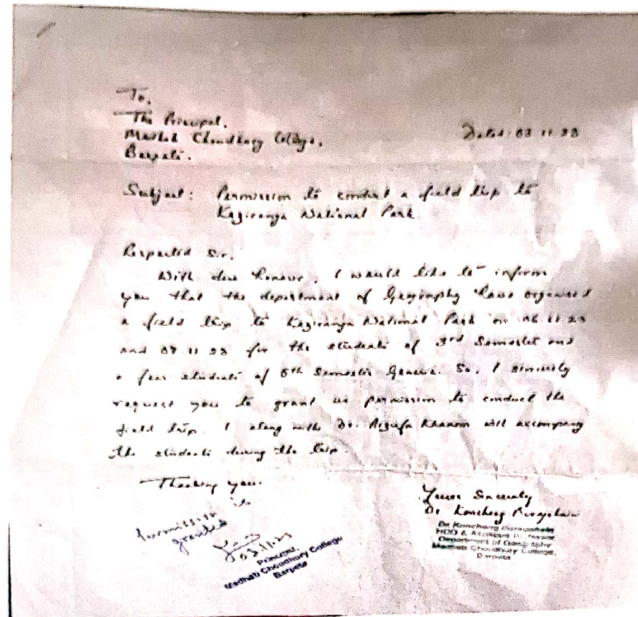
The safari in the park allowed students to witness the park's diverse wildlife and understand the need for sustainable tourism and the significance of community involvement.





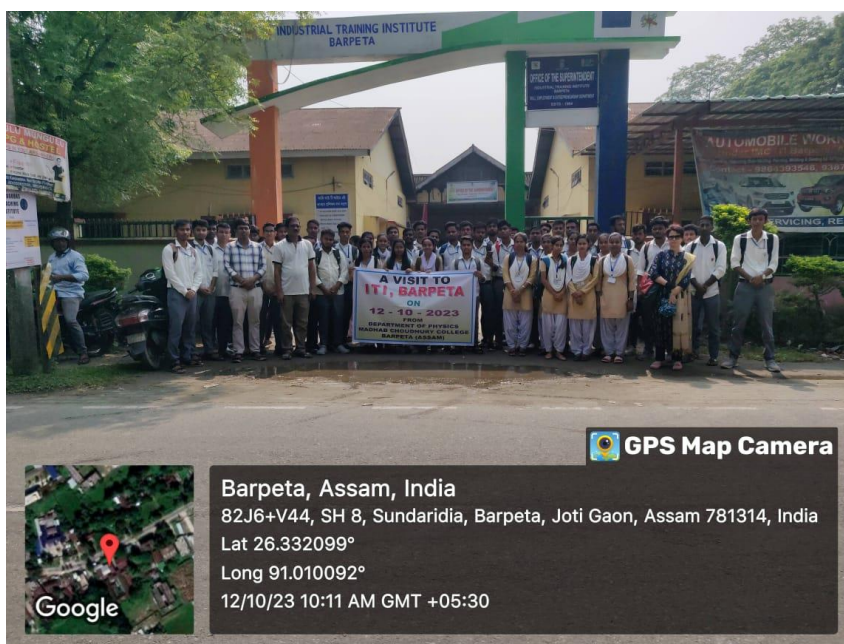


## Report on Field Visit
