- An evaluation report from the Internship Supervisor at the host organization.

##### **b) Work Demonstration:**

- Submission of a detailed internship report

  
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- A seminar presentation by the intern, evaluated by a committee of teachers/experts appointed by the Controller of Examinations.

c) Evaluation Criteria:

- Format and quality of the internship report.
- Acquisition of skill sets relevant to the internship domain.
- Originality and innovative contributions demonstrated during the internship.
- Significance of research outcomes and practical implications.
